

**BEARVILLE TOWNSHIP
BURIAL FEES**

The Bearville Township Board of Supervisors has enacted the following fee policy for payment of burials in the Bearville Township Cemetery.

Cost of Family Lot (6 sites) - \$500.00

Single Site - \$125.00

<u>Urn Burial</u>			\$150.00
<u>Summer Burial Fees</u>	May 1 through November 14		\$750.00
<u>Winter Burial Fees</u>	November 15 through April 30	Deposit	\$1,200.00
		Minimum	\$750.00

This fee will be prorated, the actual costs determined by weather conditions, snow, frost, temperature, accessibility. The charges will apply if an attempt is made to open a site, even though it may not be possible to complete.

Plowing of the road -	minimum \$ 50.00
Find, clear and measure the lot	minimum \$100.00
Digging of the lot will be based on the hourly rate	minimum \$750.00

Must be done by someone approved by the Board

Additional costs: ground heaters to thaw the ground and mobilization of equipment

Due to the event that a winter burial cannot be done or completed the purchaser is responsible for any costs that have been incurred

Any damage to surrounding monuments or markers is the responsibility of the purchaser and not the cemetery and must be replaced

There is no guarantee that the lot will be open on the day of the funeral
